SFV/NELA NOW PAC ELECTION ENDORSEMENTS

The San Fernando Valley/Northeast Los Angeles NOW PAC is releasing its endorsements for the November 2, 2004 general election and has begun an independent campaign on behalf of its picks with a leaflet entitled "Un-Bought and Un-Bossed." The leaflet emphasizes that "Power goes to two poles: to those who've got the money and to those that have the people" and distinguishes the PAC from other so-called "slate mailers" by pointing out that "First, none of our members are paid for determining who goes into this leaflet. Secondly, candidates can't pay us a fee for their endorsement, the way a lot of other "slate mailers" do. Finally, we have a very strict conflict of interest policy that our members adhere to."
